

Getting Started

Element Series System Requirements

- Apogee Element Series Thunderbolt Audio Interface
- USB port on Thunderbolt-equipped Mac
- Mac OS 10.10 or greater
- Memory: 4 GB RAM minimum, 8 GB recommended

Install Element Control Software

Apogee Control requires the installation of Element Control software to operate.

- Download the latest Element Software Package from www.apogeedigital.com/support
- 2. Open the downloaded .dmg file and double-click the Element Installer.pkg that's inside.
- 3. Follow the prompts provided by the software installer package. You will be required to restart your computer.

Connect Apogee Control to your computer

Using the provided USB cable, connect Apogee Control to any USB port on your Mac. You can even use the USB ports on your wired Apple keyboard.

Apogee Control In Use

Using the Input, Headphone and Speaker focus buttons plus the Control knob, Element input and output levels may be adjusted rapidly and effortlessly.

1. To adjust input gain, select the desired input channel by tapping the Input focus button until the desired channel number indicator LED is lit. Then, turn the Control knob to adjust the input gain. The Analog Level setting (Mic, Line or Instrument) of each channel is also indicated to the left.





- 2. To adjust headphone level, select headphone output 1 or 2 by tapping the Headphone focus button, then turn the Control knob to the desired level (with Element 24, it's not necessary to select a headphone output - there's only one.)
- 3. To adjust the speaker level, simply tap the Speaker focus button and turn the Control knob to the desired level.

Configure Apogee Control

Once Element Control software is installed and Apogee Control is connected, the 8 Function buttons are assigned as shown at right


- Buttons 1 thru 4: Input settings
- Buttons A thru D: Output settings
- Control Knob Tap: Output Mute

To customize the Function buttons and Control Knob tap:

- Open Element Control, then choose Window > Remote or click the Remote button in the Toolbar.
- In the Remote window, assign the desired functionality for the 8 Function buttons and the Control knob tap by clicking a button in the Remote Control Assignments window and selecting the function in the displayed list.


